## **DOCUMENTS AND WORK PRODUCT**

The company elected to convert the Chapter 11 bankruptcy case to one under Chapter 7 (Liquidation) on May 26, 2004.

NADN had about 7,000 square feet of file storage space filled with personal papers, tax returns, audit notes, and bank records. It is our intention to allow you to have these items returned to you.

We will be filing a motion with the Court to allow the bankruptcy estate to return those items to you and charge you an administrative fee for storage, searching for, retrieving, packaging and mailing the items back to you. That reasonable administrative fee has not been determined yet.

We intend to publish those procedures on the website in the next two weeks. We anticipate that we will hold this option to retrieve papers open for a four month window, then those papers will be destroyed.
